Phonics - Tricky Word Tuesday - Play tricky word bingo to practise writing the tricky words we have been learning. Use the sheet with the tricky words on to help you know which words to choose from. In school, we usually ask children to make 4 squares on their board or paper and write a word in each. Then we read out or show a word and if children have it they cross it off. This helps children practise both reading and writing their tricky words. If you still have a copy of these words from last week you could also play snap!

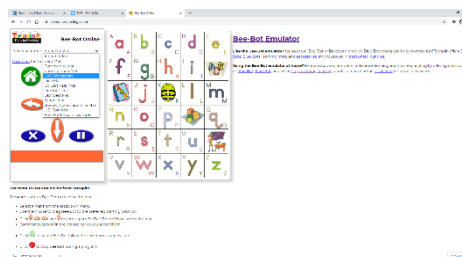
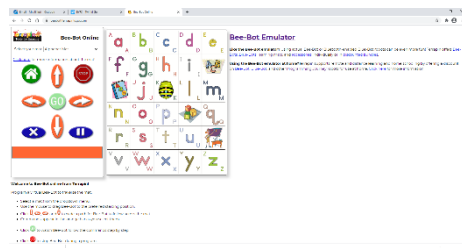

Challenge Tuesday - We are exploring technology this week. In school we are using the Beebot and Beebot app on the iPad to practise programming. You can download the Beebot app at home or go to <https://beebot.terrapinlogo.com/>. Use the arrows and buttons on the left-hand side to navigate Beebot around the mat. You could give your child letters to find. You can change the mat using the drop down arrow. You could sound talk some CVC words pictured and try to navigate Beebot to the correct picture. Have fun!



If you are unable to access the app or the website, you could see if you have any toys at home that require programming, or instructions, to help them move. If not, have you got any remote-controlled toys that you could set up an obstacle course for them to navigate around? This will practise the ideas of direction and giving instructions just as the Beebot does.
