Phonics: Use Espresso <https://central.espresso.co.uk> - English - Phonics - Scully's Phonics Phase 5 - Different ways to say 'y' (i/igh/ee)

Watch the video then complete the sorting and reading activities.

Reading: Research key facts about Spectacled Bears, Peru, The Andes & Rainforests

Spectacled Bears - www.bbc.co.uk, The Spectacled Bear/A Bear called Paddington

Peru - I will add a Fact File to Teams / email if not using Teams

The Andes - Espresso, KS2 Geography, Mountains, Fact File

Rainforests - Espresso, KS1 Science, Habitats, Video with transcript

Writing: Write a paragraph about each of the above which you have researched in your new blue lined English book. Remember to give each paragraph a sub-heading and write information sentences including technical words. You could add a picture after each paragraph!

Dragonflies & Butterflies - At least x5 sentences per paragraph

Ladybirds & Bees - At least x4 sentences per paragraph

Caterpillars - At least x3 sentences per paragraph

Spellings: Practise the spellings for your group, x10, x8 or x6 (included in your paper work pack) by writing them in your home spelling book 3 times.

Then at the end of the week take a mini spelling quiz with an adult. The focus this week is adding -ed, -er and -est to a word ending in -y with a consonant before it.

Handwriting: Follow the Nelson Handwriting Units (10 - 14) that are copied in your homework folder (1 unit = 1 focus and 1 extension activity per week). Practise your handwriting in your little purple handwriting book which is also provided in your pack. Unit 10 is the focus for this week which is to practise the horizontal join using the 'ou' digraph spelt both 'ou' and 'ow'.

SPAG: Use the Y2 Skill Builders text book and complete work in blue SPAG exercise



Maths: Focus - Number & Place Value, Mental Addition and Subtraction:

Understand place value in numbers up to 100 and begin to use this to add and subtract 2-digit numbers.

Use Espresso: KS1 Maths, Place value, Watch Videos, Play activities then complete p.2, 3 & 4 in Abacus Workbook 2 to consolidate Place value

Use your given 100 grid to practise counting forwards and backwards in 10s from any 2-digit number. Complete p.5, 6, 7 & 8 in Abacus Workbook 2 to practise mentally adding and subtracting 10, then 11, then 9. (Use 100 Grid to support)

Homework sheet will be added to Teams to summarise the maths learning for the week

Finally consolidate with the game 'Starfish Strike' in Bronze, Silver & Gold levels on Active Learn Primary.

Science: Our new topic for this term is 'Animals including Humans'.

Go onto Teams and watch the 'Animal Babies' PowerPoint attached.

Use the back of their English books, labelled Science, to draw & label pairs of animals - the adult and their young from each animal group. E.g. Mammals: Bear & Cub, Birds: Penguin & Chick, Amphibians: Frog & Tadpole, Reptiles: Snake & Hatchling, Fish & Fry.

Topic: 'Paddington Bear' use all your research about Spectacled Bears to create a piece of artwork using any available resources you have at home.

E.g. A drawing/painting of a Spectacled Bear in its' natural habitat, a collage of Paddington Bear wearing his famous hat, duffle coat & boots etc.

Computing: Use <https://central.espresso.co.uk> to complete the KS1 Computing, Online Safety. Watch the first x3 videos and complete x2 activities (Private or not? and Computers everywhere!)

PE: Complete the daily physical activities at home for Move It Monday,
