### Home Learning Week Three: 25-1-21

Hello everyone,

Here is our weekly overview. It includes a range of activities, tasks and resources to support your learning at home. Remember you can send your updates and photographs to my teacher email:

Documents to support your learning at home can be located on your Microsoft Teams account using your Teams login and password.

**Phonics:** Use Espresso <https://central.espresso.co.uk> - [English - Phonics - Scully's Phonics Phase 5](#) - Different ways to say 'c' (s)

Watch the video then complete the sorting and reading activities.

**Reading:** 'Making Bread' Instructions Comprehension Text. Read the text together then use this to complete the x6 different types of questions. Remind children to use their comprehension strategies:

- (1) Read question
- (2) Underline the question word & other important words
- (3) Look for answer/clues in the text & underline these
- (4) Answer the question using any given spellings from the text

The 'Making Bread' text and comprehension questions will be attached to Teams.

**Writing:** With your parents/carers make a marmalade sandwich (or use whatever sweet sandwich filling you already have in your house e.g. Honey, Jam, Chocolate Spread) for you and your favourite teddy bear.

Then in your English books write a set of instructions: 'How to make a Marmalade Sandwich'. Begin with what 'You will need:' Bullet point ingredients and equipment, then write numbered instructions of each step needed.

Remember to start each instruction with a bossy verb e.g. Spread, Cut, Slice, Taste etc

I will attach to Teams a word bank and a checklist for how to write a set of instructions. You could end your set of instructions with a question e.g. What is your favourite sandwich filling? Do you like marmalade?

**Spellings:** Practise Week 3 spellings for your group, x10, x8 or x6 (included in your paper work pack) by writing them in your home spelling book 3 times.

Then at the end of the week take a mini spelling quiz with an adult. The focus this week is adding -ing, -ed, -er, -est and -y to words ending in -e with a consonant before them.

**Handwriting:** Follow the Nelson Handwriting Units (10 - 14) that are copied in your homework folder (1 Unit = 1 focus and 1 extension activity per week). Practise your handwriting in your little purple handwriting book which is also provided in your pack. Unit 12 is the focus for this week which is to practise joining to the letter 'r' e.g. ar, air, are.

**SPAG:** Use the Y2 Skill Builders text book and complete work in blue SPAG exercise book which are both provided in your pack. Unit 10 Using 'ing' for actions in the present is the focus this week.

All groups complete Activity 1: Add the correct form of the verb 'to be'

All groups except Caterpillars complete Activity 2: Correctly re-write the given letter

**Maths:** Focus - Addition of two 2-digit numbers, 3D Shapes & their properties

Add two 2-digit numbers by counting on in 10s then 1s e.g.  $32+24=32+20=52$  then  $52+4=56$

Name 3D shapes and identify their properties: no of faces, vertices, edges, shape of faces etc

Use Espresso: KSI Maths, Addition & Subtraction, x4 activities to practise addition: Adding 2-digit no + 1s, Adding 2-digit no + 10s, Adding 2-digit nos within & across 10s (Focus only on addition)

Use Espresso: KSI Maths, Geometry, Watch x3 Videos: 3D shapes around us, 2D shapes on surface of 3D shape & Guess the 3D shape. Play x3 Games: Name the 3D shape, Properties of 3D shapes, 2D faces on 3D shapes & Venn Diagram 3D shapes

For addition complete p.20 & p.21 (Use 100 grid to support counting on the 10s then the 1s)

For 3D shapes complete p.22, p.23, p.24 & p.25

Homework sheet will be added to Teams to summarise the maths learning for the week

Finally consolidate with the game 'Bubble Burst' in Bronze, Silver & Gold levels on Active Learn Primary.

**Science:** Our new topic for this term is 'Animals including Humans'.

Go onto Teams and watch the 'Basic Needs' PowerPoint attached. Use the back of their English books, labelled Science, to complete the Basic Needs activity. You can either cut & stick the labels or write the labels into the right categories:

Mammals, Reptiles & Birds or Fish & Other Sea Creatures

Discuss what do they eat, how do they drink and how do they breathe?

**Topic:** Watch 'BBC Bitesize, KSI, Geography, 'Transport, Travel & Landmarks of London' (10 min video). Then use whatever resource you have available/prefer whether this is an 'Atlas' or 'Google Earth' to find the x4 countries of the United Kingdom. Additional resources will be attached to Teams to support the follow-up work. (simple map of London & PowerPoint of famous landmarks)

Use the attached sheet on Teams to locate the capital cities of the 4 countries of the UK. Then draw & label things to see & do in & around London e.g. London Zoo, London Eye, Natural History Museum, Buckingham Palace, Big Red Bus Tour of the City etc

**Spanish:** Use www.lingotot.co.uk/Oakdene.html to complete Year 2 Week 3 session, 'The Four Friends' - 'Animal Colours'. Watch the video (20mins) then choose one of the pairs games to play.

**Computing:** Use www.bbc.co.uk to access KSI Bitesize Computing. Focus on 'Computer Science', Watch 'What is an Algorithm?' 1 minute clip then discuss the x3 examples we use in our everyday lives: 1)Recipe in a cookbook 2)Set of directions to get to school/park 3)List of rules to play a game

**PE:** Complete the daily physical activities at home for Week 3 of Move It Monday, Try it Tuesday, Well-ness Wednesday, Throwback Thursday and Fit & Funky Friday. In addition to this there is Week 3 Power-Point from the Stockton Schools Sports Partnership. Both resources will be in your Teams account.
