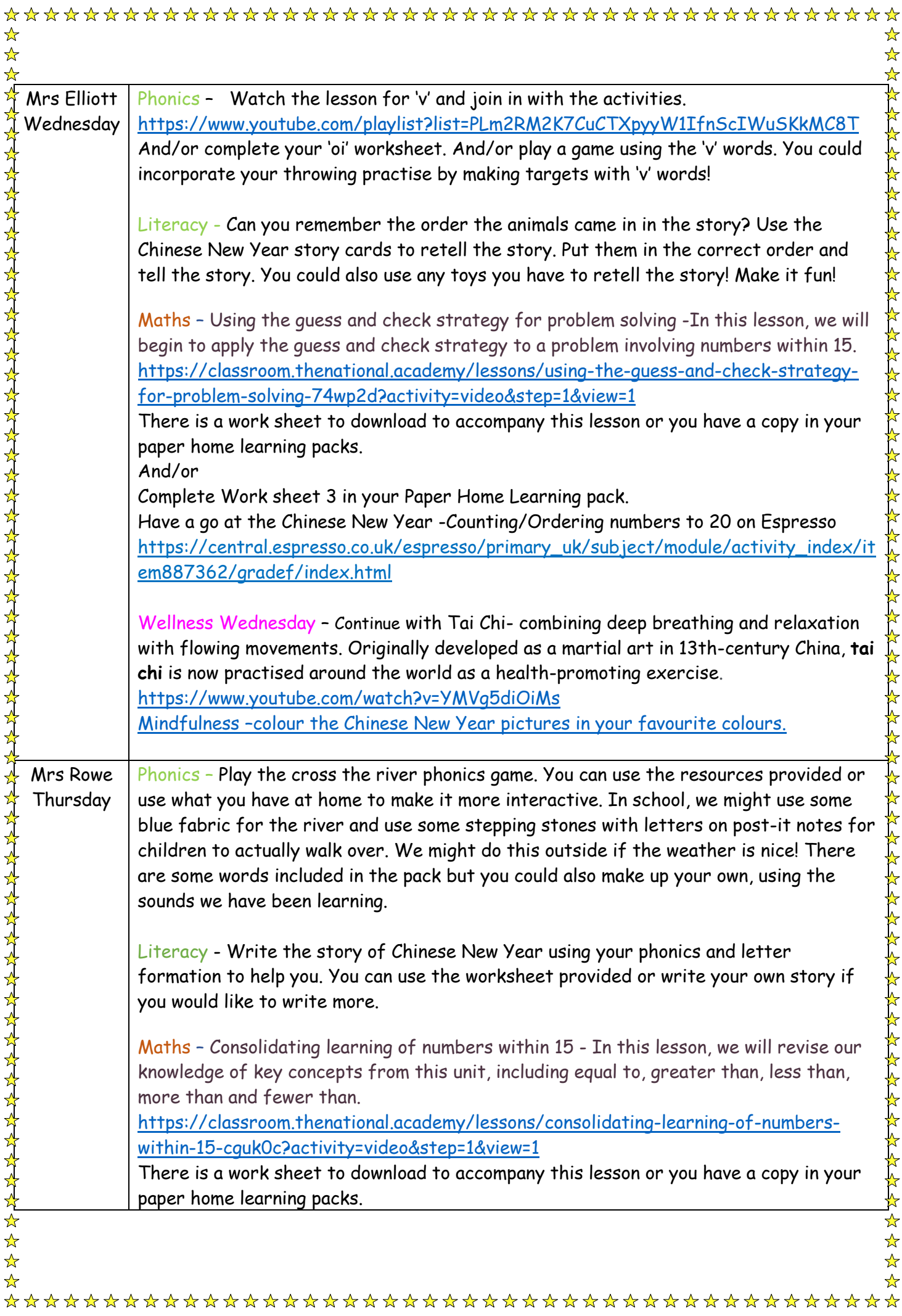

## Ongoing tasks-Early Mathematics Development

Early maths is all about fun and making things practical. Children need to explore and investigate mathematical concepts, which can help them to become more confident when approaching problem solving activities. Alongside this practical exploration children need experience of recording their learning -there are many ways to do this-photographs, worksheets, children's own forms of recording. Every day, if possible, please continue to explore numbers and number recognition-continue looking for numbers at home like last week's Number Hunt. If you are outside for exercise/walks- look for numbers on doors, car registration plates, buses, traffic signs and other places in the environment. You could practice counting steps, jumps, hops etc. counting up to 20 and beyond and back again to 0.

Number formation remains a core skill activity-use the wipe able number line (in your home paper packs) to trace numbers then practice making your own number lines 0-10 and 0-20.

If you are able to - play board games like snakes and ladders or other games with numbered spaces. Sing and recite nursery rhymes with numbers in-take videos if you can!
