Phonics: Use Espresso <https://central.espresso.co.uk> - English - Phonics - Ash's Phonics Phase 5 - focus on 'ea' 'ey' and 'e_e' this week. Watch the video and complete the blending, reading & spelling activities for each focus.

Reading: Continue to read daily at home. You can use MyOn, Oxford Owl and books/magazines you have at home. Do you have any of our Y1 Key Author books at home? - Julia Donaldson is very popular!

Spellings: Practise your week Spring 2 Week 2 spellings (included in your paper work pack) and take a mini spelling quiz with an adult at the end of the week.

Handwriting: Follow the Nelson Handwriting Units 6-10 that are copied in your new pack (1 Unit = 1 focus and 1 extension activity per week). Practise your handwriting in your little purple handwriting book. This week you will need to complete Unit 7 focus and extension sheets.

SPAG: Follow the Y1 Skills Builders English sheets (1 Unit per week). This week you will need to complete Unit 7 Singular & Plural, Activities 1-4

Writing: Now you know the story and have completed lots of word work around the book, can you follow the instructions to make a mini information booklet based on one of Julia Donaldson's Ugly Five. Use the information on your plan to complete each page in your very best handwriting. I can't wait to see them! Use the instruction sheet on to help you set it out correctly. Remember to draw wonderful pictures.

World Book Day - Dress up or down for World Book Day. Enjoy a day of World Book Day activities!

Wellness Wednesday - Share a book with someone in your family.



Maths: Focus - Number Facts - Use:

Work in your Abacus Workbook 2 to complete pages 40, 41, 42 & 43 (1 page per day). Finally consolidate with the game 'Starfish Strike' in Bronze, Silver & Gold levels on Active Learn Primary and continue to work through the games.

Science: Birds: Can you compare birds with humans? Discuss the main differences and record your differences on your worksheet. Can you complete the sentences? [Use the birds resources on Espresso to help you \(Book & Video\)](#)

Topic: What was the Great Fire of London? Research information about the great fire and create a poster/information page. You can create and display this in any way you like: drawings, writing, computer/ipad etc.

Computing: This week we are learning about direction. Can you give clear direction to someone in your house to get them to something. *For example: To get mum to the fridge you could say: Stand up, take 4 steps forward, turn left, take 4 steps forward, turn left, take 2 steps forward.* Try this game:

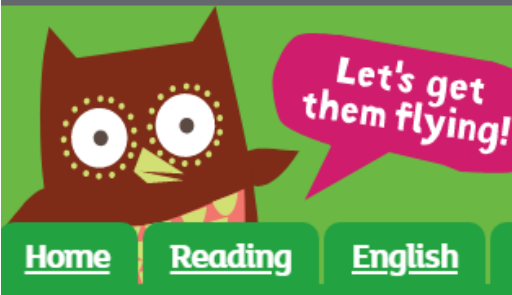
