Phonics: Congratulations on completing Phase 4! You are now ready for Phase 5. Use Espresso <https://central.espresso.co.uk> - English - Phonics - Ash's Phonics Phase 5 - focus on 'ay' and 'a-e' this week. Watch the video and complete the blending, reading & spelling activities for each focus.

Reading: Read Julia Donaldson 'The Ugly Five' to help with your writing task this week. If you do not have a copy of this book, you can find it using this link:

<https://youtu.be/O4ejuiTNhvc> Continue to read daily at home. You can use MyOn, Oxford Owl and books/magazines you have at home.

Spellings: Practise your Spring 2 week 2 spellings (included in your new paper work pack - delivered Monday 22nd Feb) and take a mini spelling quiz with an adult at the end of the week.

Handwriting: Follow the Nelson Handwriting Units 6-10 that are copied in your new pack (1 Unit = 1 focus and 1 extension activity per week). Practise your handwriting in your little purple handwriting book. This week you will need to complete Unit 6 focus and extension sheets.


SPAG: Follow the Y1 Skills Builders English sheets (1 Unit per week). This week you will need to complete Unit 10 - What is a sentence? Activity 3.

Writing: Session 1: Re-read or watch Julia Donaldson's story 'The Ugly Five' & discuss the scientific words used throughout. What do they mean? How do we know? Look some of the words up online and write definitions down. **Session 2:**

Can you use any of the words in sentences of your own, in your English book.

Sessions 3 & 4: Use your planning sheet to write key words about one of the animals

Session 5: Finish it with a picture and start to talk about using your key words in sentences - this is next weeks challenge!

Science: Our new topic for this term is 'Animals - Birds!'. Go onto Teams and look carefully at the PowerPoint attached. Can you identify and name common British garden birds?

Topic: Who was George Stephenson? Use the PowerPoint/factsheet and information to learn about his life and the impact his invention has had on travel today. Complete your own George Stephenson fact file.

PE: Complete the daily physical activities at home for Move It Monday, Try it Tuesday, Wellness Wednesday, Throwback Thursday and Fit & Funky Friday. You will find the grid on your Teams account. If you haven't got the resources required, please be creative with your sessions.
