**Literacy** - Label a farm animal. You could complete the 'Labelling a dairy cow' worksheet in your pack or you could choose a different animal and label the different parts of its body. You could draw the animal or cut it out from your Farmyard Hullabaloo animals sheet.

**Maths** - Recap 2D shapes with the following activities (you can do as many or as few as you would like):

As we learn about farms and follow on from Fairtrade week, we are thinking about the ways we can help to look after the world. We will also pick up on this later in the week in our literacy work.

And/or play a game using the 'er' words.</p> <p><b>Literacy/Understanding the World</b> - Write clues about a farm animal and see if someone else can guess what it is. You could email the clues to Mrs Elliott and see if she can guess if you like! You will need to think carefully about the features of the animal, like we did when labelling on Monday. For example, "I have 4 legs. I have a tail. It is a curly tail. I can oink. What am I?"
